This is The Events Centre, Caloundra building.  
This is where I am going to see a show.



When I arrive, I will walk into the venue front door, walk past the  
Box Office and then get to the foyer.  
This is a big area where people wait outside the theatre.  
Sometimes the foyer can be crowded and noisy.



This is the Box Office. If I don't already have my tickets, I can go here to pick up my tickets. As I'm walking into the venue via the main entry, it is located on the right hand side.



If I need any assistance, I can ask an usher. They are in the shirts with The Events Centre logo.



This is the Café area near the Playhouse Theatre, I can buy food and drinks.



This is the Bar area next to the Café area where I can also buy food and drinks. The Café and Bar area might be loud with noise of people chatting and eating.



This is the outdoor patio near the Café and Bar where I can enjoy my pre-show dining. It might be loud with noise from the road.



The bathroom is available before the show near the Playhouse Theatre.



There is a breakout space (Reef Room) around the corner from the Playhouse Theatre.

This is available at all times if I need a break.  
There will be signs directing me to this space.



There will be bells to let me know when the theatre doors open. An usher will check my tickets and direct me into the theatre.



After checking my ticket, the usher at the door will direct me into the theatre by going up these stairs or through Pumicestone Passage.



This is Pumicestone Passage which is located on the side of the theatre. I can also get into the theatre through here.



I can find my seat by looking at my ticket which will have a row and seat number. There will be an usher inside the theatre to help if I need it.



This is the what the Playhouse Theatre looks like. I will sit in one of these seats to watch the show. I will get to sit with my family or friends. There may be people that I don't know sitting beside me.



The play will happen on the stage. The show will start once the lights go down. Sometimes things might seem sad, scary, or loud. I have to remember that what is happening on stage isn't real. The actors are performing.



Sometimes during the show there may be loud noises. The actors on stage may warn me before this happens so I can be prepared. I can put on my headphones or cover my ears. Sometimes there will be bright lights. They look like this.
