The Events Centre, Caloundra | Playhouse Theatre



This is The Events Centre, Caloundra building.
This is where I am going to see a show.



When I arrive, I will walk into the venue through the front door,
walk past the Box Office and into the foyer. This is a big area
where people wait outside the theatre. Sometimes the foyer can
be crowded and noisy.



This is the Box Office. This is where people collect their ticket. As I'm walking into the venue via the main entry, it is located on the right hand side.



If I need any assistance, I can ask an usher. They are in the shirts with The Events Centre logo.



The toilets are available before the show near the Playhouse Theatre.



There will be bells to let me know when the theatre doors open. An usher may scan my ticket and will direct my school group into the theatre.



When I enter the theatre, I will go up these stairs or through Pumicestone Passage.



This is Pumicestone Passage which is located on the side of the theatre. I can also enter the theatre through here.



This is the what the Playhouse Theatre looks like. I will sit in one of these seats to watch the show. I will sit with my friends and teachers. There may be people that I don't know sitting beside me.





The show will happen on the stage. The show will start once the lights go down. Sometimes things might seem sad, scary, or loud. I have to remember that what is happening on stage isn't real. The actors are performing. Sometimes during the show there may be loud noises, bright lights or a smoke machine.



At the end of the show, I can clap along with the rest of the audience to show my enjoyment and appreciation.



Once the show is finished, the lights will come back on, and I will leave the theatre.
